



## **Federal Poverty Guidelines for the United States, 2011.**

In order to be eligible for participation in a matched savings program, an applicant needs to demonstrate proof of income **BELOW** 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. For example: for a household of **4**, the income threshold would be **\$44,700**. See the *Federal Poverty Guidelines for the United States (2011)* below to determine your applicant's eligibility.

2	\$14,710
3	\$18,530
4	\$22,350
5	\$26,170
6	\$29,990
7	\$33,810
8	\$37,630
*For families with more than 8 persons, add \$3,820 for each additional person.
